



Dress Code

Recreational Combo Class

- Leotard or Biketard: any color; (no sports bras or booty shorts)
- Hair: should be in a ponytail or bun. If you have short hair, it needs to be secure and out of the face.
- Shoes: Revolution tap, ballet, or jazz shoes should be worn. These are purchased through Upstage.
- Tights: any color footed or stirrup tights

Recreational Tumbling Class

- Leotard or Biketard: any color, (no sports bras or booty shorts)
- Hair: should be in a ponytail or bun. If you have short hair, it needs to be secure and out of the face.
- Shoes: no shoes
- Tights: any color stirrup tights

Recreational/Competitive Ballet Class

- Leotard: black, NO SPORTS BRA
- Hair: should be in a ballet bun. If you have short hair, it needs to be secure and out of the face.
- Shoes: Canvas ballet shoes (Competition), Revolution ballet shoes (Recreational)
- Tights: pink footed tights

Recreational/Competitive Hip Hop Class

- Black tank top/t-shirt, black booty shorts or leggings
- Hair: should be in ponytail or bun. If you have short hair, it needs to be secure and out of the face.
- Shoes: Hip hop sneakers purchased through Upstage.

Tap, improv, Tumbling, Turns & Leaps, Stretching Class, Productions, Routine Practice

- Black leotard, sports bras or booty shorts
- Hair: should be in a SECURE bun (not messy). If you have short hair, it needs to be secure and out of the face.
- Shoes: appropriate shoes, no socks (except for tap class)
- Tights: any color footed, stirrup tights, or no tights

Boys

- Tap, Jazz, Improv, Turns & Leaps, Stretching Class, Productions, Hip Hop, Routine Practice: Black Shirt, Black Shorts, Appropriate Shoes (no socks)
- Ballet: Black Compression Shirt, Black Men Tights, Ballet Canvas Shoes

Studio Rule: No street shoes of any kind are allowed on any dance floor. Please make sure all dance shoes are put on students prior to coming into each studio. No Dance Shoes should be worn outside.
